

Civility Policy

The faculty and staff of the Newberry Community School will treat parents and other members of the public with respect and will expect the same in return. The Newberry Community School is committed to maintaining orderly educational and administrative processes in keeping school, administrative offices, and school related events free from disruptions and preventing unauthorized persons from entering school grounds.

The aim is to promote mutual respect and orderly conduct within the school, thereby setting a model for children and others in the community. It is not meant to deprive any person of the right to freedom of expression. Volatile, hostile or aggressive actions and words are discouraged, and individuals who engage in these activities may face legal penalties and possible dismissal of their student by the school. All students and parents must support this policy and have a signed civility policy on file in the school office.
